



# Corona Protocol V.V. Kroton

*Despite the circumstances, the season '21-'22 has started and everyone is excited to play volleyball again. Together we are trying to make volleyball as "normal" as possible, while of course taking into account the measures surrounding COVID-19.*

*The ACLO and the Sports Centre have drawn up important rules to reduce the risk of coronavirus infections. We, the student volleyball association Kroton, therefore urge you to comply with these rules and measures when you arrive at the sports center where our home games are held, so that everyone can continue to play volleyball and practice other sports.*

*Should there be any questions or ambiguities based on this document, you are always free to contact our board of the association.*

## A. Upon entering the sports centre:

- a. Please disinfect hands upon entry.
- b. Audiences are **not** allowed during the matches. There is only room in the competition hall for the people who have filled in the DWF form.
- c. If people come along for transport, we would ask them to take a seat in the Sportsbar.
- d. Make as little use as possible of the changing rooms. So come to the matches already dressed.
- e. There is **no** room for team meetings in the changing rooms of the sports center. If there is no possibility to do so in advance and it is considered necessary, we ask you to either find a place outside or in the Sportsbar. However, this is only possible when there is room for it.
- f. 45 minutes before the start of the match, the **captain** of the team is asked to report to the board table (which is in front of the competition hall). 10 minutes before the warm-up, the team may enter the competition hall.
- g. Waiting rooms will be set up in which teams can sit if the game played before them has not ended yet. Within this "waiting room" teams are still expected to keep 1.5 metres away from each other.

## B. During the matches:

- a. Counting boards, referee chairs and player benches are expected to be cleaned after each use. Teams will be asked during the toss if they wish to switch sides per set. If both sides cannot come to an agreement, a decision will be made to play 2 sets on the same side.



- b. To improve ventilation in our competition hall, the doors will be open throughout the day. However, this may cause the hall to be colder during the matches. **So be prepared for this by dressing warm enough, also during the competition!**

**C. After the match:**

- a. After the match has ended, you are requested to leave the competition hall as soon as possible. Possible post-match discussions are only allowed in the Sportsbar or outside, only if there is space.
- b. If it is necessary to shower after the match, **do so immediately**. The changing rooms will have a limited capacity, so take this into account.
